The lands East of 99 FWY, Sherwood Ave. going South to Whisler Road, and 99 FWY going East to Driver Road. This annexation was initiated by the City for the purpose of future development. The surrounding properties are agricultural land, including two dairies and numerous agricultural ponds, and scattered rural residences. This proposal has 100% landowner consent. (Resolution)
